Courtyard Marriott Downtown:

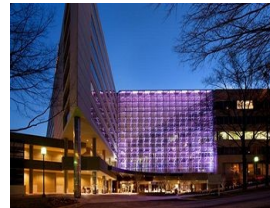
Located in the heart of Downtown Greenville, the Courtyard Marriott Downtown features 135 rooms, meeting space, fitness facility, and The Bistro

Located in Travelers Rest, the Cafe is a convenient stop off the Swamp Rabbit Trail - perfect for a bite to eat.

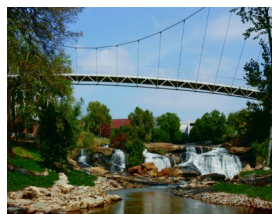
